Church in the World**Food Closet & Thanksgiving Baskets Update**

I must start off this article by giving a big shout-out to Rich Kowalski and Jim and Margaret Hall, without whose muscle power and pickup trucks, we would have been in trouble today. We just returned from delivering **70** Thanksgiving meals (38 from Southminster and 32 from Fort Lee's Army Logistics University students) to the fairgrounds for CCHASM Thanksgiving.

Thank you for responding to this wonderful program. It is an extension of our Food Closet ministry, which, in the first three quarters of this year, has served 178 families. CCHASM has added a new feature for those families who are unable to drive to a pantry; Door Dash now collects food from Southminster and delivers it to those clients. As you can imagine, just from your own grocery bills, the demand is increasing. So far this year, Southminster has spent 2 to 3 times what we spend in an average year, so donations are always appreciated.

Remember that the last Sunday of the month is an opportunity to contribute to the Cents-ability offering. The idea is to multiply the number of meals you prepare in a month by 5 cents. So, a family of 2 would figure 2 people X 3 meals a day X 30 days in the month, to come up with \$18.00 as an offering, but any amount is, of course, welcome! Thank you for the generosity that allows us to continue this important ministry. And many thanks to all the volunteers whose devotion makes this such a vital and smooth operation.
