### WE ARE NEVER NOT CALLED

In the *Christian Century* magazine, Paul Wadell has an essay about his elderly parents, and their sense of grace and gratitude. He writes:

Baptism initiates Christians into a magnanimous adventure in which we are called to imitate Christ by growing in goodness, generosity, service and love. Even though what this might mean changes as we move through different stages of our lives, we are never not called to bring Christ to life for others.

### **Nehemiah Action Report**

We had 38 people from Southminster Church attended the annual RISC Nehemiah Action at the Richmond Convention Center on April 5th. You can read about it (front page news) in the Richmond Times Dispatch article, "Congregations Lobby Richmond, Chesterfield to Allocate Funding for Mobile Home Repair." Those Southminster members who attended the Nehemiah Action were invited to Southminster on Wednesday, April 27<sup>th</sup> to give their thoughts on and evaluate the event. Rev. Charlie Summers and Emily Small, RISC lead organizer led the meeting.

### **One Great Hour of Sharing**

The One Great Hour of Sharing special offering was officially collected on Easter Sunday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, but to our extreme gratification we saw generous donations come in all through the month of April. We are pleased to report that we collected \$1,466.00 for the One Great Hour of Sharing in 2022 at the time of this printing. Donations are used domestically and globally by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) for three outreach missions: hunger assistance, natural disaster relief, and self-development of people.

Hunger actions include helping with immediate needs and addressing chronic poverty and its effects. In disaster relief, both the physical and the emotional needs of affected persons are addressed. Self-development of people helps those experiencing oppression, injustice, and poverty and to educate all Presbyterians about how these experiences affect our brothers and sisters.

### **Southminster Scholarship**

The youth and young adults in our congregation have been blessed by the generosity of former and current members who contribute to our Scholarship Fund, helping our young members with college expenses. All eligible Southminster youth are encouraged to apply for the Southminster Scholarship.

Applicants must be confirmed members of Southminster and attend at least two worship services or church-sponsored events each year. (The Scholarship Committee will offer grace on the participation requirement due to the extraordinary circumstances of 2021.) Applications and guidelines will be available at the church and will also be mailed to eligible students. If you think you are eligible and do not receive this mailing by the end of April, please contact the church office at 804-276-1749. Applications are due by June 15, 2022.

# News from Our Children's Nursery and Children's Sunday School


